Summary of Commission

City Arts is currently engaging older people in care in arts programmes. This year Nottingham City Council has funded an opportunity for City Arts to commission a digital/light artist to produce a piece of work for Light Night 2018.

The artist will design and propose a digital, interactive or light installation to be exhibited in a 6 by 12ft window at City Arts in Nottingham, engaging older people in a co-produced artwork.

The installation will be installed from Monday 5th February until 26th February. The Light Night event will take place on Friday February 23rd.

Commission

- 4 workshops with older people (in care) in early January
- A design concept taking on board co-production elements from participants
- Artist to complete the design and install the window for 5th February
- Uninstall window on Monday 26th February

To Apply:

1. Copy of your CV
 2. No more than 2 page proposal (on A4) of your design concept and idea, including how the older people contribute to the co-design/final outcome
- Why you want to apply
 - The process
 - How you would engage care home residents
 - Theme/idea concept
 - Style/approach (models of working)
 - How you would develop interactive/participatory/musical and sensory elements within the piece
 - Budget (including installation time and materials)

- Any other information you wish to include
3. Examples of past work – links to online content (videos, images etc), websites, reviews etc
